Pursuant to the Medium Density Residential (R-2) and Mixed Use-Airport (MU-A) District regulations and Section 146-5.4.3.B.3.c of the Unified Development Ordinance, City of Aurora, Colorado, the administrative application for Picadilly Road Infrastructure Site Plan is:

This decision shall become effective after the second City Council meeting following notice of this decision to the City Council. Before the effective date of this decision, the City Council may move to consider the application and affirm, overrule, or modify this decision. You may also appeal this decision to the City Council. An appeal must be filed with the City Manager’s office within ten calendar days from the date of this decision. Abutting property owners may also file an appeal within ten calendar days from the date of this decision.

Based on the information contained in the application. The following are findings of fact as applied to the criteria for approval in Section 146-5.4.3.B.3.c of the Unified Development Ordinance:

Minor Site Plan Criteria for Approval

- 1. The Minor Site Plan shall be approved only if the application complies with the applicable standards in this UDO, other adopted City regulations, any approved Master Plan that includes the property, and any conditions specifically applied to the development of the property by the Planning and Zoning Commission or City Council in a prior decision affecting the property. If the application does not comply with those standards, the Planning Director will notify the applicant of what other permits, approvals, or changes to the application are required for compliance.*

The proposed Infrastructure Site Plan complies with the standards of the NEATS Refresh, meets the intent of the Aurora Places Comprehensive Plan to provide infrastructure that will support development in the surrounding area; and complies with the Unified Development Ordinance.

Condition of Approval:

1. Resolution of outstanding technical issues prior to the recordation of the Site Plan.
