Comments: Metro Center is amending the Master Plan to remove Dawson as a city street, adjacent to the RTD Park-n-Ride. This street will be replaced with a pedestrian corridor that connects the Alameda Parkway trail easement to the southern parcels in the Master Plan. This change affects multiple example renderings, diagrams and notes throughout the Design Guidelines to coordinate this revised design concept.

The Metro Center Design Guidelines are one of the tools the Design Review Committee uses to evaluate development proposals. Attached to this memo is the updated Design Guideline Document for your file and future use. The changes are tracked in a redline cloud and in a page-by-page tracker, attached to this memo.

The Design Review Committee has a formal process for project review and approval outlined in Section 7 of the Guidelines. There is no formal process for review and approval of the Guidelines themselves.

As the Design Coordinator, I recommend the Unconditional Approval of the Metro Center Design Guidellines.
