This letter serves as meeting summary for the community meeting that was held on June 1, 2024 from 9:00-12:00 for the City of Aurora Fire Station #9 project, located at 17200 E. Mexico Avenue.

The community was invited to learn about the planned demolition of the existing station, see the exterior renderings and floor plan of the new station, and be informed about the estimated construction schedule. Questions at the meeting primarily centered around the need for a new station and the relocation of the station's crew during construction, as well as when demolition would begin for the existing station. Tours of the existing station were provided which clearly demonstrated the need to replace the 46-year-old station. Staff from Aurora Fire Rescue were on hand to explain that the crew would be at nearby Station 7 and that response to the area would be handled by the apparatus closest at the time of the call.

There were no concerns brought up by community members in relation to the project or station design. An article on the project was also published in the Sentinel Colorado on February 7, 2024.
